How often should I have my car's wheels aligned?

Always follow your manufacturers recommendations outlined in your owners manual. In general, wheels should be aligned every 10,000 miles driven or once a year.

How often should I change my car's oil?

Although with progressing technology manufacturers are extending and recommending oil change intervals, we still recommend that you change your oil every 3 months or 3,000 miles to keep your engine running properly.

No, a car is only a total loss when the price of repairs exceeds the value of the car.
